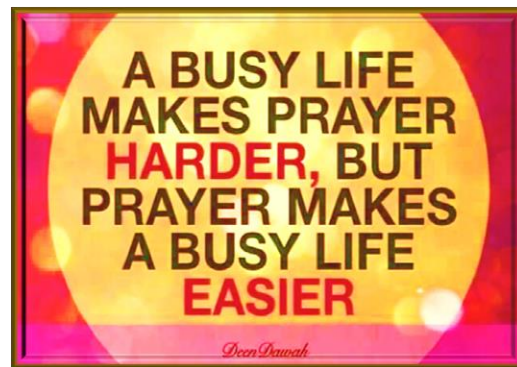

Vision to Action. Follow up meeting!

Sunday April 14 following the 10:30am worship service.

Please plan to join the parish for a follow up to our Vision to Action meeting previously held on March 3rd. We will share feedback from the community and make some decisions about preparing to receive proposals from developers. If you have not yet offered feedback on the yellow sheets in the Fireside Lounge, or in the green book in the office or via email, please do so soon.

One of the topics addressed on March 3 was distinguishing between a “Lease” agreement and a “Limited Partnership”. Some of the main differences are listed here. Please keep in mind there are exceptions as well as advantages and disadvantages to both. The following is a very general overview. More specifics can be discussed with our Trinity Centres Foundation partners. An open bidding process will generate proposals from a wide variety of developers, and we can counter-offer based on our goals for our property.



Lease Agreement

Long Term (50-60 years+)

Revenue is clearly defined and predictable.

Terms of use clearly defined.

Less desirable for investors so **less bids.**

Limited Partnership

Length of Partnership Negotiated.

Revenue less predictable.

Shared use of property so terms more negotiable.

Better value for investors so **more quality bids.**

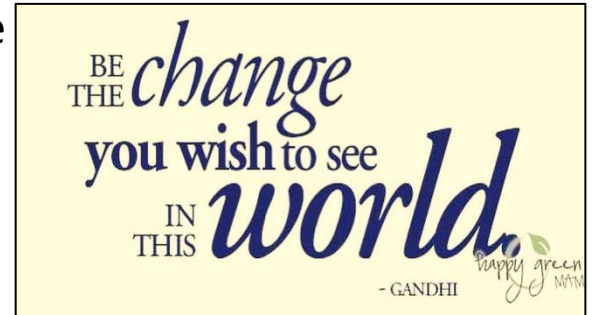
Let's Do It, And Bin It Where It Belongs!
